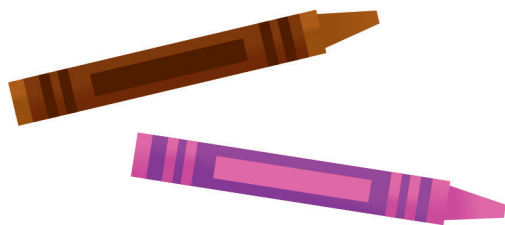

Activity

Case of the Wiggles

What You Need:

No supplies needed

What You Do:

Before the Activity: Invite your kid to play.

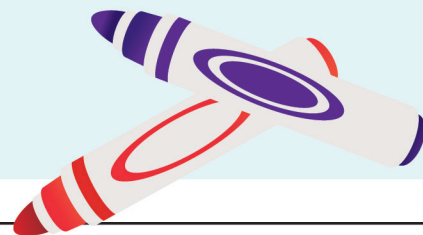
What You Say:

Before the Activity: "Come play with me!"

During the Activity: Say, "I will call out a part of your body, and I want you to wiggle it! Are you ready? Let's wiggle our fingers!"

Continue with the body part list, adding to or changing it for your needs. For example: Fingers, Feet, Mouth, Hands, Head, Shoulders, Hips, Elbows, Nose, Knees, Ears, Toes, Tummy, etc.

After the Activity: Say, "Did you get your wiggles out? Tell me, who made your wiggly ears and toes and fingers? (*Pause.*) God did! You are wonderfully made by God! Who made you wonderful? God made me wonderful!"
