The Supernatural Desire and Ability of:

- **Message of Wisdom:** Provide insight and guidance from the Holy Spirit.
- **Message of Knowledge:** Know facts and truths supernaturally revealed by the Holy Spirit.
- **Faith:** Trust unwaveringly in God's power and promises.
- **Gifts of Healing:** Heal physical, emotional, or spiritual ailments.
- **Miraculous Powers:** Perform extraordinary, supernatural acts.
- **Prophecy:** Proclaim God's message with authority and clarity, providing direction, encouragement, and correction.
- **Distinguishing between Spirits:** Discern the source of spiritual manifestations.
- **Speaking in Different Kinds of Tongues:** Speak in languages unknown to the speaker.
- **Interpretation of Tongues:** Interpret messages spoken in tongues for the church's edification.
- **Apostleship:** Pioneer new ministries, oversee, and unite various Christian communities.
- **Teaching:** Help others understand and apply God's Word effectively.
- **Helping:** Support and assist others in practical ways.
- **Administration:** Organize and manage the church effectively.

- **Prophecy:** Proclaim God's message with authority and clarity.
- **Serving:** Meet practical needs within the church and community.
- **Teaching:** Instruct others in the truths of the Christian faith.
- **Encouragement:** Inspire and motivate others to live out their faith.
- **Giving:** Contribute resources generously and cheerfully.
- **Leading:** Govern and direct the church with wisdom and care.
- **Showing Mercy:** Provide compassionate care and support to those in need.

These spiritual gifts equip the church for ministry, build up the body of Christ, and serve the broader community. The Holy Spirit distributes these gifts according to His will for the benefit of the church and the glory of God.
