DISCUSSION GUIDELINES

COME REGULARLY

Just like any friendship, cultivating a healthy relationship with Jesus and others in your group starts with showing up! When you prioritize regular attendance with your group, you make a difference for yourself and others participating as well.

PARTICIPATE

Your story and life experience is a testimony to the character of God. When you share what God is doing in and around you, it helps everyone in your group understand more of who God is and build meaningful relationships within your group.

KEEP IT SAFE

During discussion, everyone is responsible for helping maintain an environment where people can be heard and feel loved. Please allow everyone an opportunity to speak and refrain from quick answers, snap judgments, or simple fixes.

CONFIDENTIALITY

We encourage and value honesty, transparency, and vulnerability. To help protect these values and each other, please keep anything shared in your group confidential.

KNOW & BE KNOWN

In group discussions, pay attention to the stories people share about their lives. As you get to know each other and learn about what is happening in each others' lives you will have opportunities to pray heaven to earth and see God's kingdom advance.

Note for Group Leaders: If there is something shared in your group that you believe is serious, involves potential or existing harm to a person, or requires additional pastoral care, please encourage that group member to share with a pastor at your campus or bring the situation to a pastor's attention.
