



101 Bible passages that speak to a final judgement (NET)

THE CHAPEL

1. **Genesis 18:25:** Far be it from you to do such a thing—to kill the righteous with the wicked, treating the righteous and the wicked alike. Far be it from you! Will not the Judge of all the earth do what is right?
2. **Deuteronomy 32:41:** I will sharpen my lightning-like sword, and my hand will grasp hold of the weapon of judgment; I will execute vengeance on my foes, and repay those who hate me.
3. **1 Samuel 2:10:** The LORD shatters his adversaries; he thunders against them from the heavens. The LORD executes judgment to the ends of the earth. He will strengthen his king and exalt the power of his anointed one.
4. **1 Chronicles 16:33:** Then the trees of the forest will shout for joy before the LORD, for he is coming to judge the earth.
5. **Job 19:29:** Fear the sword yourselves, for wrath brings the punishment by the sword, so that you may know that there is judgment.
6. **Psalms 1:5:** Therefore the wicked will not stand in the judgment, nor sinners in the assembly of the righteous.
7. **Psalms 50:21-22:** When you did these things and I kept silent, you thought I was exactly like you. But I now arraign you and set my accusations before you. “Consider this, you who forget God, or I will tear you to pieces, with no one to rescue you.
8. **Psalms 96:13:** before the LORD, for he comes. For he comes to judge the earth. He will judge the world in righteousness, and the peoples in his faithfulness.
9. **Psalms 110:6:** He will judge the nations, heaping up the dead and crushing the rulers of the whole earth.
10. **Proverbs 21:2:** A person may think their own ways are right, but the LORD weighs the heart.
11. **Ecclesiastes 3:17:** I said to myself, “God will bring into judgment both the righteous and the wicked, for there will be a time for every activity, a time to judge every deed.”
12. **Ecclesiastes 11:9:** You who are young, be happy while you are young, and let your heart give you joy in the days of your youth. Follow the ways of your heart and whatever your eyes see, but know that for all these things God will bring you into judgment.
13. **Ecclesiastes 12:13-14:** Having heard everything, I have reached this conclusion: Fear God and keep his commandments, because this is the whole duty of man. For God will evaluate every deed, including every secret thing, whether good or evil.
14. **Isaiah 25:8:** he will swallow up death permanently. The sovereign LORD will wipe away the tears from every face, and remove his people's disgrace from all the earth. Indeed, the LORD has spoken.

15. **Isaiah 26:9:** My soul yearns for you in the night; in the morning my spirit longs for you. When your judgments come upon the earth, the people of the world learn righteousness.
16. **Isaiah 54:17:** no weapon forged against you will prevail, and you will refute every tongue that accuses you. This is the heritage of the servants of the LORD, and this is their vindication from me,” declares the LORD.
17. **Isaiah 66:22-24:** “For just as the new heavens and the new earth I am about to make will remain standing before me,” says the LORD, “so your descendants and your name will remain. From one month to the next and from one Sabbath to the next, all people will come to worship me,” says the LORD. “They will go out and observe the corpses of those who rebelled against me, for the maggots that eat them will not die, and the fire that consumes them will not die out. And they will be loathsome to all humankind.”
18. **Jeremiah 25:31:** The tumult will resound to the ends of the earth, for the LORD will bring charges against the nations; he will bring judgment on all mankind and put the wicked to the sword,” declares the LORD.
19. **Ezekiel 33:20:** Yet you Israelites say, ‘The way of the Lord is not just.’ But I will judge each of you according to your own ways.”
20. **Daniel 7:9-10:** As I looked, thrones were placed, and the Ancient of Days took his seat; his clothing was white as snow, and the hair of his head like pure wool; his throne was fiery flames; its wheels were burning fire. A stream of fire issued and came out from before him; a thousand thousands served him, and ten thousand times ten thousand stood before him; the court sat in judgment, and the books were opened.
21. **Daniel 12:1-3:** “At that time Michael, the great prince who watches over your people, will arise. There will be a time of distress unlike any other from the nation’s beginning up to that time. But at that time your own people, all those whose names are found written in the book, will escape. Many of those who sleep in the dusty ground will awake – some to everlasting life, and others to shame and everlasting abhorrence. But the wise will shine like the brightness of the heavenly expanse. And those bringing many to righteousness will be like the stars forever and ever.
22. **Joel 3:2:** I will gather all nations and bring them down to the Valley of Jehoshaphat. There I will put them on trial for what they did to my inheritance, my people Israel, because they scattered my people among the nations and divided up my land.
23. **Zechariah 13:8-9:** It will happen in all the land,” says the LORD, “that two-thirds of the people in it will be cut off and die, but one-third will be left in it. Then I will bring the remaining third into the fire; I will refine them like silver is refined and will test them like gold is tested. They will call on my name and I will answer; I will say, ‘These are my people,’ and they will say, ‘The LORD is my God.’”

24. **Malachi 3:5:** “So I will come to put you on trial. I will be quick to testify against sorcerers, adulterers and perjurers, against those who defraud laborers of their wages, who oppress the widows and the fatherless, and deprive the foreigners among you of justice, but do not fear me,” says the LORD Almighty.
25. **Matthew 5:12:** Rejoice and be glad, because your reward is great in heaven, for they persecuted the prophets before you in the same way.
26. **Matthew 6:19-21:** “Do not accumulate for yourselves treasures on earth, where moth and devouring insect destroy and where thieves break in and steal. But accumulate for yourselves treasures in heaven, where moth and devouring insect do not destroy, and thieves do not break in and steal. For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.
27. **Matthew 7:1-3:** “Do not judge so that you will not be judged. For by the standard you judge you will be judged, and the measure you use will be the measure you receive. Why do you see the speck in your brother’s eye, but fail to see the beam of wood in your own eye?”
28. **Matthew 7:21-23:** “Not everyone who says to me, ‘Lord, Lord,’ will enter the kingdom of heaven, but only the one who does the will of my Father who is in heaven. Many will say to me on that day, ‘Lord, Lord, did we not prophesy in your name and in your name drive out demons and in your name perform many miracles?’ Then I will tell them plainly, ‘I never knew you. Away from me, you evildoers!’
29. **Matthew 10:15:** I tell you the truth, it will be more bearable for the region of Sodom and Gomorrah on the day of judgment than for that town!
30. **Matthew 11:22, 24:** But I tell you, it will be more bearable for Tyre and Sidon on the day of judgment than for you... But I tell you that it will be more tolerable for the land of Sodom on the day of judgment than for you.
31. **Matthew 12:36-37:** I tell you, on the day of judgment people will give account for every careless word they speak, for by your words you will be justified, and by your words you will be condemned.
32. **Matthew 12:41-42:** The men of Nineveh will stand up at the judgment with this generation and condemn it; for they repented at the preaching of Jonah, and now something greater than Jonah is here. The Queen of the South will rise at the judgment with this generation and condemn it; for she came from the ends of the earth to listen to Solomon’s wisdom, and now something greater than Solomon is here.
33. **Matthew 13:40-43:** As the weeds are pulled up and burned in the fire, so it will be at the end of the age. The Son of Man will send out his angels, and they will weed out of his kingdom everything that causes sin and all who do evil. They will throw them into the blazing furnace, where there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth. Then the righteous will shine like the sun in the kingdom of their Father. Whoever has ears, let them hear.

34. **Matthew 13:49-50:** This is how it will be at the end of the age. The angels will come and separate the wicked from the righteous and throw them into the blazing furnace, where there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.
35. **Matthew 16:27:** For the Son of Man will come with his angels in the glory of his Father, and then he will reward each person according to what he has done.
36. **Matthew 18:6-9:** “If anyone causes one of these little ones—those who believe in me—to stumble, it would be better for them to have a large millstone hung around their neck and to be drowned in the depths of the sea. Woe to the world because of the things that cause people to stumble! Such things must come, but woe to the person through whom they come! If your hand or your foot causes you to stumble, cut it off and throw it away. It is better for you to enter life maimed or crippled than to have two hands or two feet and be thrown into eternal fire. And if your eye causes you to stumble, gouge it out and throw it away. It is better for you to enter life with one eye than to have two eyes and be thrown into the fire of hell.
37. **Matthew 18:35:** “This is how my heavenly Father will treat each of you unless you forgive your brother or sister from your heart.”
38. **Matthew 19:28-29:** Jesus said to them, “Truly I tell you, at the renewal of all things, when the Son of Man sits on his glorious throne, you who have followed me will also sit on twelve thrones, judging the twelve tribes of Israel. And everyone who has left houses or brothers or sisters or father or mother or wife or children or fields for my sake will receive a hundred times as much and will inherit eternal life.
39. **Matthew 23:33:** “You serpents, you brood of vipers, how are you to escape being sentenced to hell?”
40. **Matthew 24:36:** “But about that day or hour no one knows, not even the angels in heaven, nor the Son, but only the Father.

41. **Matthew 25:14-30:** “For it is like a man going on a journey. He summoned his slaves and entrusted his property to them. To one he gave five talents, to another two talents, and to another one talent, each according to his ability. Then he went on his journey. The one who received the five talents went out immediately and put his money to work and gained five more. In the same way, the one who had two gained two more. But the one who received the one talent went out and dug a hole in the ground and hid his master’s money. After a long time the master of those slaves came and settled accounts with them. The one who had received the five talents came and brought five more, saying, ‘Master, you gave me five talents. See, I have gained five more.’ His master replied, ‘Well done, good and faithful slave! You have been faithful with a few things. I will put you in charge of many things. Enter into your master’s joy.’ The one with the two talents also came and said, ‘Master, you gave me two talents. See, I have gained two more.’ His master replied, ‘Well done, good and faithful slave! You have been faithful with a few things. I will put you in charge of many things. Enter into your master’s joy.’ And the one with the one talent also came and said, ‘Master, I knew that you are a hard man, harvesting where you have not sown, and gathering where you have not scattered seed. So out of fear I went away and hid your talent in the ground. See, you have what is yours.’ His master replied, ‘You evil, lazy slave! If you knew that I harvest where I have not sown and gather where I have not scattered, then you should have deposited my money with the bankers, and when I returned I would have received my money back with interest! So take the talent from him and give it to the one who has ten talents. For the one who has will be given more, and he will have more than enough. But the one who does not have, even what he has will be taken from him. And throw that worthless slave into the outer darkness, where there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.’

42. **Matthew 25:31-46:** “When the Son of Man comes in his glory, and all the angels with him, then he will sit on his glorious throne. All the nations will be assembled before him, and he will separate people one from another like a shepherd separates the sheep from the goats. He will put the sheep on his right and the goats on the left. Then the king will say to those on his right, ‘Come, you who are blessed by my Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world. For I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me something to drink, I was a stranger and you invited me in, I needed clothes and you clothed me, I was sick and you took care of me, I was in prison and you came to visit me.’ Then the righteous will answer him, ‘Lord, when did we see you hungry and feed you, or thirsty and give you something to drink? When did we see you a stranger and invite you in, or needing clothes and clothe you? When did we see you sick or in prison and go to visit you?’ The king will answer them, ‘I tell you the truth, just as you did it for one of the least of these brothers or sisters of mine, you did it for me.’ Then he will say to those on his left, ‘Depart from me, you cursed, into the eternal fire prepared for the devil and his angels. For I was hungry and you gave me no food, I was thirsty and you gave me nothing to drink, I was a stranger and you did not invite me in, I needed clothes and you did not clothe me, I was sick and in prison and you did not take care of me.’ Then they too will answer, ‘Lord, when did we see you hungry or thirsty or a stranger or naked or sick or in prison, and did not help you?’ He will answer them, ‘I tell you the truth, just as you did not do it for one of the least of these, you did not do it for me.’ And these will depart into eternal punishment, but the righteous into eternal life.”
43. **Mark 16:16:** The one who believes and is baptized will be saved, but the one who does not believe will be condemned.
44. **Luke 6:37:** “Do not judge, and you will not be judged; do not condemn, and you will not be condemned; forgive, and you will be forgiven.
45. **Luke 12:2-3:** Nothing is hidden that will not be revealed, and nothing is secret that will not be made known. So then whatever you have said in the dark will be heard in the light, and what you have whispered in private rooms will be proclaimed from the housetops.
46. **Luke 12:46:** the master of that slave will come on a day when he does not expect him and at an hour he does not foresee, and will cut him in two, and assign him a place with the unfaithful.
47. **John 3:17-18:** For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world should be saved through him. The one who believes in him is not condemned. The one who does not believe has been condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of the one and only Son of God.
48. **John 3:36:** The one who believes in the Son has eternal life. The one who rejects the Son will not see life, but God's wrath remains on him.
49. **John 5:22:** For the Father judges no one, but has assigned all judgment to the Son.

50. **John 5:24:** “I tell you the solemn truth, the one who hears my message and believes the one who sent me has eternal life and will not be condemned, but has crossed over from death to life.
51. **John 5:27-29:** and he has granted the Son authority to execute judgment, because he is the Son of Man. Do not be amazed at this, because a time is coming when all who are in the graves will hear his voice and will come out—the ones who have done what is good to the resurrection resulting in life, and the ones who have done what is evil to the resurrection resulting in condemnation.
52. **John 12:47-48:** If anyone hears my words and does not obey them, I do not judge him. For I have not come to judge the world, but to save the world. The one who rejects me and does not accept my words has a judge; the word I have spoken will judge him at the last day.
53. **Acts 10:42:** He commanded us to preach to the people and to warn them that he is the one appointed by God as judge of the living and the dead.
54. **Acts 17:31:** because he has set a day on which he is going to judge the world in righteousness, by the man whom he designated, having provided proof to everyone by raising him from the dead.”
55. **Acts 24:15:** I have a hope in God (a hope that these men themselves accept too) that there is going to be a resurrection of both the righteous and the unrighteous.
56. **Acts 24:25:** While Paul was discussing righteousness, self-control, and the coming judgment, Felix became frightened and said, “Go away for now, and when I have an opportunity, I will send for you.”
57. **Romans 2:1-12:** Therefore you are without excuse, whoever you are, when you judge someone else. For on whatever grounds you judge another, you condemn yourself, because you who judge practice the same things. We know that the judgment of God is in accordance with truth against those who practice such things. But do you presume this, O man—who judges those who practice such things and yet does them yourself—that you will escape the judgment of God? Or do you have contempt for the wealth of his kindness, forbearance, and patience, and yet do not know that God's kindness leads you to repentance? But because of your stubbornness and your unrepentant heart, you are storing up wrath for yourselves in the day of wrath, when God's righteous judgment is revealed! He will reward each one according to his works: eternal life to those who by perseverance in good work seek glory and honor and immortality, but wrath and anger to those who live in selfish ambition and do not obey the truth but follow unrighteousness. There will be affliction and distress on everyone who does evil, on the Jew first and also the Greek, but glory and honor and peace for everyone who does good, for the Jew first and also the Greek. For there is no partiality with God. For all who have sinned apart from the law will also perish apart from the law, and all who have sinned under the law will be judged by the law.

58. **Romans 2:16:** on the day when God judges the secrets of human hearts, according to my gospel through Christ Jesus.
59. **Romans 6:23:** For the payoff of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.
60. **Romans 8:1-2:** There is therefore now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus. For the law of the life-giving Spirit in Christ Jesus has set you free from the law of sin and death.
61. **Romans 8:33:** Who will bring any charge against God's elect? It is God who justifies.
62. **Romans 14:4:** Who are you to pass judgment on another's servant? Before his own master he stands or falls. And he will stand, for the Lord is able to make him stand.
63. **Romans 14:10-12:** Who are you to pass judgment on another's servant? Before his own master he stands or falls. And he will stand, for the Lord is able to make him stand. One person regards one day holier than other days, and another regards them all alike. Each must be fully convinced in his own mind. The one who observes the day does it for the Lord. The one who eats eats for the Lord because he gives thanks to God, and the one who abstains from eating abstains for the Lord, and he gives thanks to God.
64. **1 Corinthians 3:11-15:** For no one can lay any foundation other than the one already laid, which is Jesus Christ. If anyone builds on this foundation using gold, silver, costly stones, wood, hay or straw, their work will be shown for what it is, because the Day will bring it to light. It will be revealed with fire, and the fire will test the quality of each person's work. If what has been built survives, the builder will receive a reward. If it is burned up, the builder will suffer loss but yet will be saved—even though only as one escaping through the flames.
65. **1 Corinthians 4:1-5:** This, then, is how you ought to regard us: as servants of Christ and as those entrusted with the mysteries God has revealed. Now it is required that those who have been given a trust must prove faithful. I care very little if I am judged by you or by any human court; indeed, I do not even judge myself. My conscience is clear, but that does not make me innocent. It is the Lord who judges me. Therefore judge nothing before the appointed time; wait until the Lord comes. He will bring to light what is hidden in darkness and will expose the motives of the heart. At that time each will receive their praise from God.
66. **1 Corinthians 15:26:** The last enemy to be eliminated is death.
67. **2 Corinthians 5:10:** For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, so that each may receive recompense for what he has done while in the body, whether good or evil.

68. **1 Corinthians 9:24-27:** Do you not know that all the runners in a stadium compete, but only one receives the prize? So run to win. Each competitor must exercise self-control in everything. They do it to receive a perishable crown, but we an imperishable one. So I do not run uncertainly or box like one who hits only air. Instead I subdue my body and make it my slave, so that after preaching to others I myself will not be disqualified.
69. **Ephesians 2:1-3:** And although you were dead in your offenses and sins, in which you formerly lived according to this world's present path, according to the ruler of the kingdom of the air, the ruler of the spirit that is now active in the sons of disobedience, among whom all of us also formerly lived out our lives in the cravings of our flesh, indulging the desires of the flesh and the mind, and were by nature children of wrath even as the rest.
70. **Ephesians 6:8:** because you know that the Lord will reward each one for whatever good they do, whether they are slave or free.
71. **Colossians 3:23-24:** Whatever you are doing, work at it with enthusiasm, as to the Lord and not for people, because you know that you will receive your inheritance from the Lord as the reward. Serve the Lord Christ.
72. **2 Timothy 4:1:** I solemnly charge you before God and Christ Jesus, who is going to judge the living and the dead, and by his appearing and his kingdom.
73. **2 Timothy 4:7-8:** I have competed well; I have finished the race; I have kept the faith! Finally the crown of righteousness is reserved for me. The Lord, the righteous judge, will award it to me in that day—and not to me only, but also to all who have set their affection on his appearing.
74. **Hebrews 6:2:** teaching about baptisms, laying on of hands, resurrection of the dead, and eternal judgment.
75. **Hebrews 9:27:** And just as people are appointed to die once, and then to face judgment.
76. **Hebrews 10:30:** For we know the one who said, “Vengeance is mine, I will repay,” and again, “The Lord will judge his people.”
77. **Hebrews 13:4:** Marriage must be honored among all and the marriage bed kept undefiled, for God will judge sexually immoral people and adulterers.
78. **James 1:12:** Happy is the one who endures testing, because when he has proven to be genuine, he will receive the crown of life that God promised to those who love him.
79. **James 2:13:** For judgment is merciless for the one who has shown no mercy. But mercy triumphs over judgment.
80. **James 3:1:** Not many of you should become teachers, my brothers and sisters, because you know that we will be judged more strictly.
81. **James 4:12:** There is only one lawgiver and judge—the one who is able to save and destroy. But who are you to judge your neighbor?

82. **James 5:12:** Above all, my brothers and sisters, do not swear an oath, either by heaven or by earth or by any other thing. But let your “Yes” be yes and your “No” be no, so that you may not fall into judgment.
83. **1 Peter 4:5:** They will face a reckoning before Jesus Christ who stands ready to judge the living and the dead.
84. **1 Peter 4:17:** For it is time for judgment to begin with the family of God; and if it begins with us, what will be the fate of those who are disobedient to the gospel of God?
85. **1 Peter 5:4:** Then when the Chief Shepherd appears, you will receive the crown of glory that never fades away.
86. **2 Peter 2:4:** For if God did not spare the angels who sinned, but threw them into hell and locked them up in chains in utter darkness, to be kept until the judgment.
87. **2 Peter 2:9:** then the Lord knows how to rescue the godly from trials and to reserve the unrighteous for punishment at the day of judgment.
88. **2 Peter 3:7:** But by the same word the present heavens and earth have been reserved for fire, by being kept for the day of judgment and destruction of the ungodly.
89. **1 John 3:14:** We know that we have crossed over from death to life because we love our fellow Christians. The one who does not love remains in death.
90. **1 John 4:17:** By this love is perfected with us, so that we may have confidence in the day of judgment, because just as Jesus is, so also are we in this world.
91. **1 Thessalonians 1:10:** and to wait for his Son from heaven, whom he raised from the dead, Jesus our deliverer from the coming wrath.
92. **1 Thessalonians 5:1-10:** Now on the topic of times and seasons, brothers and sisters, you have no need for anything to be written to you. For you know quite well that the day of the Lord will come in the same way as a thief in the night. When they are saying, “There is peace and security,” then sudden destruction comes on them, like labor pains on a pregnant woman, and they will surely not escape. But you, brothers and sisters, are not in the darkness for the day to overtake you like a thief would. For you all are sons of the light and sons of the day. We are not of the night nor of the darkness. So then we must not sleep as the rest, but must stay alert and sober. For those who sleep, sleep at night and those who get drunk are drunk at night. But since we are of the day, we must stay sober by putting on the breastplate of faith and love and as a helmet our hope for salvation. For God did not destine us for wrath but for gaining salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ. He died for us so that whether we are alert or asleep we will come to life together with him.
93. **Jude 1:6:** You also know that the angels who did not keep within their proper domain but abandoned their own place of residence, he has kept in eternal chains in utter darkness, locked up for the judgment of the great Day.

94. **Jude 1:7, 13:** As Sodom and Gomorrah, and the surrounding cities, which engaged in sexual immorality in the same way as these, are exhibited as an example by undergoing the punishment of eternal fire... wild waves of the sea, foaming out their shame; wandering stars, for whom the utter depths of eternal darkness have been reserved.
95. **Revelation 6:10:** They cried out with a loud voice, "How long, Sovereign Master, holy and true, before you judge those who live on the earth and avenge our blood?"
96. **Revelation 11:18:** The nations were enraged, but your wrath has come, and the time has come for the dead to be judged, and the time has come to give to your servants, the prophets, their reward, as well as to the saints and to those who revere your name, both small and great, and the time has come to destroy those who destroy the earth."
97. **Revelation 14:7:** He declared in a loud voice: "Fear God and give him glory, because the hour of his judgment has arrived, and worship the one who made heaven and earth, the sea and the springs of water!"

98. **Revelation 20:1-15:** Then I saw an angel descending from heaven, holding in his hand the key to the abyss and a huge chain. He seized the dragon—the ancient serpent, who is the devil and Satan—and tied him up for a thousand years. The angel then threw him into the abyss and locked and sealed it so that he could not deceive the nations until the one thousand years were finished. (After these things he must be released for a brief period of time.) Then I saw thrones and seated on them were those who had been given authority to judge. I also saw the souls of those who had been beheaded because of the testimony about Jesus and because of the word of God. These had not worshiped the beast or his image and had refused to receive his mark on their forehead or hand. They came to life and reigned with Christ for a thousand years. (The rest of the dead did not come to life until the thousand years were finished.) This is the first resurrection. Blessed and holy is the one who takes part in the first resurrection. The second death has no power over them, but they will be priests of God and of Christ, and they will reign with him for a thousand years. Now when the thousand years are finished, Satan will be released from his prison and will go out to deceive the nations at the four corners of the earth, Gog and Magog, to bring them together for the battle. They are as numerous as the sands of the seashore. They went up on the broad plain of the earth and encircled the camp of the saints and the beloved city, but fire came down from heaven and devoured them completely. And the devil who deceived them was thrown into the lake of fire and sulfur, where the beast and the false prophet are too, and they will be tormented there day and night forever and ever. Then I saw a large white throne and the one who was seated on it; the earth and the heaven fled from his presence, and no place was found for them. And I saw the dead, the great and the small, standing before the throne. Then books were opened, and another book was opened—the book of life. So the dead were judged by what was written in the books, according to their deeds. The sea gave up the dead that were in it, and Death and Hades gave up the dead that were in them, and each one was judged according to his deeds. Then Death and Hades were thrown into the lake of fire. This is the second death—the lake of fire. If anyone's name was not found written in the book of life, that person was thrown into the lake of fire.
99. **Revelation 21:4:** He will wipe away every tear from their eyes, and death will not exist any more—or mourning, or crying, or pain, for the former things have ceased to exist.
100. **Revelation 21:8:** But to the cowards, unbelievers, detestable persons, murderers, the sexually immoral, and those who practice magic spells, idol worshipers, and all those who lie, their place will be in the lake that burns with fire and sulfur. That is the second death.
101. **Revelation 22:11-12:** The evildoer must continue to do evil, and the one who is morally filthy must continue to be filthy. The one who is righteous must continue to act righteously, and the one who is holy must continue to be holy.” “Look! I am coming soon, and my reward is with me to pay each one according to what he has done!
